3. Kids Q judging will be held at 11:00 am. Meat is sausage and must be supplied by team.
4. Safety of this event is paramount! Any unsafe acts or safety issues identified by Mark Twain Landing Staff will be immediately corrected. Failure to follow the directions of the staff may result in removal from Mark Twain Landing.
